



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

MARBLE SURFACE

The marble has been treated with a sealant, however it is still very fragile and susceptible to staining as it is a natural material with a honed finish. If treated improperly, the marble can be stained, etched, or abraded. It is best to use a dry, or damp cloth to wipe the surface as needed.

Please follow the instructions listed below in order to best care for your surface:

Wipe up all spills immediately

Clean with a neutral cleaner, or a mild liquid dishwashing detergent and warm water

Use trivets or mats under hot dishes and cookware

Use placemats under china, ceramics, silver and other objects that can scratch the surface

Use coasters under glasses, especially if they contain alcohol or citrus juices

Don't use cleaners that contain acid such as bathroom cleaners, grout cleaners or tub cleaners

Don't use vinegar, bleach, ammonia or other general-purpose cleaners

Don't use abrasive cleaners such as dry cleaners or soft cleansers

Don't use scouring powders and abrasives because they will scratch the surface

BRASS

The brass has been brush finished and clear coated to prevent tarnish. Some natural tarnishing will occur over time and create a natural patina. Clean by dusting with a dry/soft cloth. Please refrain from using any liquid or chemical cleaning solutions as they will affect the finish. Do not use a metal polishing cream on the brushed surfaces as this will affect the consistency of the finish and coating.

STEEL

Clean the black steel surface by dusting with a dry/soft cloth or applying a mild detergent. Polish in the direction of the grain using baby oil. Please refrain from using chemical cleaning solutions as they will affect the finish. Do not use a metal polishing cream on the brushed surfaces as this will affect the consistency of the finish and coating.
